



CAMP SITE TERMS & CONDITIONS 2011

CAMP SITE DATES

1. Camping is only available from Monday 15 August 12noon – Tuesday 22 August 10.00 am 2011.
2. Notification of extended period of stay must be arranged with Camp Site Administration Office one day prior to original departure date.
3. Camping fees must be paid in advance of arrival at the camp site and are non-refundable.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

4. Campers must report to the Camp Site office for site allocation. All fees must be paid to the Airshow office prior to your arrival.

FACILITIES - AVAILABILITY & USE

5. There are a limited number of powered sites available.
6. BBQs & gas lanterns may be used; however no open fires are permitted.
7. Use of generators is not permitted, before 7.00am and after 9.00pm.
8. Children under the age of 10 years must be accompanied to showers and toilets by a responsible adult.
9. Notification of equipment malfunction (e.g. showers, toilets etc.) should be made to Camp Site Office for rectification.
10. Caravans and campervans can access community tap sites. No individual caravan taps or grey water facilities are available. Visitors must provide buckets for the catchment of all liquid waste. Buckets are to be emptied at the toilet block facilities only. A designated grey water dumpsite is located within close proximity to the campsites and further details are available at check-in.
11. Loud music is not permitted.

LOST OR FOUND PROPERTY

12. Articles lost or found should be reported to Camp Site Office. There are no facilities available for the storage of personal property or valuables.

BEHAVIOUR

13. Behavior must be of an acceptable standard at all times. Disturbances or other inappropriate behavior will be reported to camp site security or police for appropriate action.



14. Please respect other campers! Excessive noise after 10 pm will not be permitted.
15. Vandalism and/or damage to any property, buildings, and vegetation will not be tolerated and offenders will be asked to leave the camping area.
16. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and may at their sole discretion require persons to leave the camping area. Inappropriate behaviour may result in all persons from the offending camp site being evicted.

GENERAL

17. All persons using the Camp Site are required at all times to comply with all instructions and directions issued by the organisers and its officials and/or authorised officers.
18. If any injury is sustained by any person while in the Camp Site, the incident must be reported to the Camp Site Office as soon as practicable and preferably within 12 hours.
19. Untidy litter around the camp sites will not be permitted and use should be made of the rubbish bins provided.
20. In the event of an emergency, any directives given by Police, Security or Event organisers must be observed.
21. All persons using the Camp Site do so at their own risk. The Organisers will not accept responsibility for negligent acts or omissions of any person other than the organisers or their officials, servants or agents.
